
## **VV1 Additions Modifications**

## Approved Styles: Front Door & Storm Door

(1) Front storm/security doors: Color - same as front door. No bare aluminum storm doors are approved. If the front door is natural wood-grain finish, the storm door color must be the trim color. (There is no approved front door burglar bar style.) During the regular painting cycle, an assessment of the condition of storm doors will be made. If a storm door needs painting, the owner will be so advised. The owner will then be required to paint the door at his/her own expense using a color consistent with the above paint color







## Approved Entry Door Styles


A resident may replace any existing door with one of the five non-premium doors without consulting with the Architectural Committee as such a replacement is a maintenance operation and does not involve an addition or modification. Anyone desiring replacing an existing door with the premium style must consult the Architectural Committee to obtain information on the exact model and vendor.


During the painting cycle, a resident is given the opportunity to select the fill color for his/her home. The color of the front door must be then selected from either the trim color of the fill color. If the door is a natural wood-grain finish, the resident may apply to the Architectural Committee for permission to let the door remain in that style, provided the door appears to be in good condition.














Premium Door Glass must be clear




**Color:** Either original trim or fill.
